INVESTING MORE Than \$3.35M to increase Sorting Capacity

We're making investments to increase the sorting capacity of recyclables collected, improve recycling rates and help prevent plastic waste from ending up in the environment. This includes the increased sorting capacity for our valuable, 100% recyclable plastic bottles that can then be remade into new bottles, as intended.



IMPROVING RECYCLING INFRASTRUCTURE FOR ONE MILLION RESIDENTS

Four new optical sorters are expected to provide an additional 222 tons of recyclable PET and 248 tons of recyclable aluminum that can be remade into new products.

INCREASING AMOUNT OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS IN THE REGION

The recycling infrastructure upgrade is estimated to increase the amount of recyclable materials due to the decrease in residue rate and decrease in contaminated mixed paper once the MRF is fully operational.
