OUR INVESTMENT IN SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS

Through Every Bottle Back, we are investing in San Antonio, Texas to modernize collection, sortation, and processing of recyclable materials in the region.

INVESTING \$3 MILLION TO BUILD THE CITY'S MRF

Our investment will help build a brand new, state-of-the-art materials recovery facility ("MRF") from the ground up with the newest recycling technology and infrastructure to sort, clean and bale recyclable materials, such as the beverage industry's plastic and aluminum containers.



IMPROVING RECYCLING INFRASTRUCTURE

The new facility will allow materials from more than 1.45 million residents, other communities, multifamily buildings and commercial customers to be sorted and have a better chance of being remade into new products.

INCREASING RECYCLABLE MATERIALS COLLECTED IN THE REGION

The MRF is expected to yield nearly one million tons of recyclables over the next decade. This includes nearly 60,000 tons of PET plastic and more than 20,000 tons of aluminum, both of which are used to make recyclable cans and bottles





SUPPORTING LOCAL JOBS
